Entry fee for third entry of the same dog per trial\$15.00 each
Obedience Fees include the \$.50 AKC Recording Fee for the first entry of each dog, plus \$3.00 Service Fee for the first entry of each dog; and a \$3.50 Service Fee for each additional entry of a dog. Rally Fees include the AKC Recording Fee of \$3.50 for each entry.

Entries close at the Trial Secretary's address, **WEDNESDAY, MAY 22, 2024, at 5:00 PM**, unless the numerical limit is reached prior to the date after which time entries will not be accepted, cancelled, altered or substituted.

MAKE ALL CHECKS/MONEY ORDERS PAYABLE TO: MDTC.

Canadian exhibitors must make fees payable in U.S. funds. Exhibitors whose checks are returned for NSF will be assessed a \$20.00 service fee. Entries will not be accepted if received without signatures, fees and right side of Entry Form with agreement. An official American Kennel Club Entry Form must be used. **Electronic, faxed, telephone and telegraph entries cannot be accepted.** No entry will be accepted which is made subject to conditions.

NOTIFICATION MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE EVENT SECRETARY BEFORE 8 AM (CDT), SATURDAY, JUNE 8 OR SUNDAY, JUNE 9, 2024 OF A BITCH IN SEASON. Entry fee less \$5.00 processing fee will be refunded.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judges, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the Trial giving Club, it is impossible to open or complete the trials, no refund of entry fees will be made.

PLEASE NOTE: IF ENTRY IS SENT VIA NEXT DAY AIR SERVICE (UPS, AIRBORNE EXPRESS, FEDERAL EXPRESS, EXPRESS MAIL, ETC.), **PLEASE INDICATE THAT NO SIGNATURE IS NECESSARY UPON ARRIVAL OR ENTRY MAY NOT BE ACCEPTED IN TIME.**

Transfers will be allowed in accordance with the Obedience/Rally Regulations Chapter 1, Section 16.

Entries should be typed or printed except for the proper signature on Official AKC Entry Forms.

Confirmation of entry and Judging Program will be sent by email to the address printed on the Entry Form. If no email address is provided, confirmation will be sent via First Class USPS mail to the address on the Official AKC Entry Form, as soon as possible after the closing date as per AKC Rules and Regulations. ***If confirmation has not been received by June 5, 2024, please contact the Event Secretary (Email: rosesbeagles10@gmail.com).***

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

- 🐾 Building is air conditioned and heated. Trial grounds are not available the night before the trials.
- 🐾 MDTC and/or WWCDTC assume no responsibility for any injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers or their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to an exhibitor's child. Exhibitors must exercise control of their children at all times while within trial grounds.
- 🐾 Dogs need to be present only for scheduled time of judging and may be removed immediately after judging unless required for further judging. Dogs judged in Catalog order to extent it is practical without holding up judging in another ring. Judges are not required to wait for dogs and it is the exhibitor's responsibility to be ready at ringside without waiting to be called.
- 🐾 Keep show site clean; pick up after your dog. No private exercise pens are permitted in the building. Use designated exercise areas only.
- 🐾 No dogs may be left in the building overnight.
- 🐾 Only dogs entered in trials are allowed on the grounds. We request that any dog causing a disturbance be removed from the ring area. All dogs must be on leash except when being judged.
- 🐾 Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

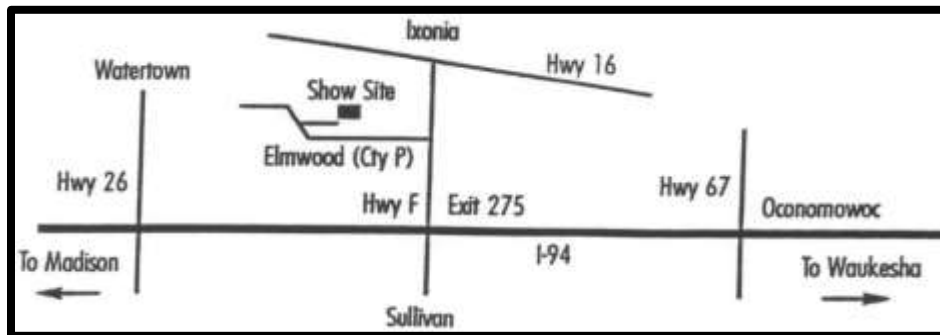

From I-94 Exit #275 Cty F Ixonia-Sullivan. Go North on Cty F about 4 miles. Turn West (left) on Elmwood Drive (Cty P) - Just before the train tracks. Turn Right on Cedar Dr. Our building is at the end of the drive on the left.

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- Dogs entering mixed breed classes (eligible only in standalone Agility, Obedience and Rally trials) should mark Breed as "MIXED BREED." Variety, Breeder, Sire, Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants. AKC Canine Partners listing number must be included on the entry form and AKC* NO. must be checked.
